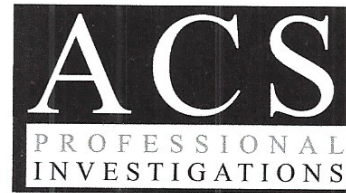




## Affidavit of Emani Gullet

1. My name is Emani Gullet, and I make this affidavit from personal knowledge of matters addressed herein.
2. On July 20, 2022 Steve Crane of ACS Professional Investigations came to my house and stated that he was hired by Arkeene Broaden's family to reinvestigate his case.
3. Mr. Crane asked me if I could tell him what happened the evening of June 28, 2015. I told Mr. Crane that on this night Arkeene Broaden invited me and my friend Daija to go to Arkeene's friend Demetrius Brown's house located at 17274 Warwick Street, Detroit, MI 48219 to party. Daija and I arrived at the house between 5:30 PM and 6:00 PM. We started to party, drinking alcohol and smoking marijuana.
4. Between 9:00 PM and 9:30 PM Daja and Arkeene got into an argument. Daja through a rock at Arkeens vehicle and broke out the back window. Arkeene got upset and left the house. As soon as Arkeene left, Daija and I left the house.
5. Arkeene never mentioned a robbery or somebody being murdered. I only heard of the robbery and the murder after Arkeene was arrested.
6. Arkeene's attorney never contacted me or asked me to testify at Arkeene's trial as one of his alibis.

This concludes my affidavit. I am willing to take a polygraph test and testify in a court of law under oath as to the contents of this affidavit.

1. My name is Ernestine Jackson, and I make this affidavit from personal knowledge of matters addressed herein.
2. On July 20, 2022 Steve Crane of ACS Professional Investigations stopped by my residence and asked me what happened the evening of June 28, 2015. I told Mr. Crane that on this night, my grandson, Arkeene Broaden called me and told me he had gotten into an argument with his girlfriend and she threw a rock through the back window of his car. This car was a rental vehicle and I told Arkeene we needed to get a police report. My husband and I met Arkeene at the 2<sup>nd</sup> precinct of the Detroit Police Department to file the police report. I believe that it was around 9:30 PM. Around 10:00 PM Arkeene's uncle, Terrance Broaden called him and informed him that his friend Martez Johnson had been killed. *I told Arkeene that his friend had died.*
3. After the information was given to the police officer my husband drove the rental car back to my residence and Arkeene and I followed behind him in my vehicle. Once home, we stayed there for the remainder of the night.

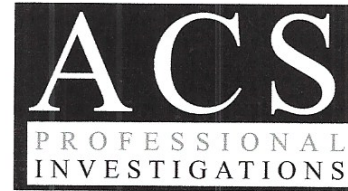

1. My name is Demetrius Brown, and I make this affidavit from personal knowledge of matters addressed herein.
2. On July 19, 2022 Steve Crane of ACS Professional Investigations called me and stated that he was hired by Arkeene Broaden's family to reinvestigate his case.
3. Mr. Crane asked me if I could tell him what happened the evening of June 28, 2015. I told Mr. Crane that on this night, Arkeene Broaden and two of his female friends, Emani and Daja came to my house located at 17274 Warwick Street, Detroit, MI 48219 between 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM to party. We started to party, drinking alcohol and smoking marijuana.
4. Around 9:00 PM and 9:30 PM Daja and Arkeene got into a fight and Daja threw a rock or brick through Arkeene's back window. Arkeene got upset and left my house. At this time, the two females also left my house. I later found out that Arkeene had called his grandmother and she made him go to the police department to file a police report because the vehicle was a rental vehicle.
5. The days after that evening everything seemed normal. Arkeene would drive me to and from school in either his Chrysler 200 or in his Charger.
6. One day my father had to drive me to school as Arkeene did not show up at my house to drive me to school. Once I got to school, officer Burton, who was one of the schools security guards as well as the school's football coach took me out of my class and asked me what happened to Arkeene as he was arrested and charged with robbery and murder. I told officer Burton that I did not know anything about a robbery or murder and was very surprised to hear this as Arkeene and I are very good friends.
7. Knowing Arkeene like I do I feel that he could never get involved in such a crime. I do know that on June 28, 2015 Arkeene was at my house with two girls between 5:00 and 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM and 9:30 PM and could not have been involved in the robbery and murder.
